I sailed from Denmark June 25 1875, at the age of eight years. Came over with my Brother age 20, and my sister age 12, my Parents coming about three years later, arrived in Richfield Utah late in July, same year. Lived with different families till my Brother got married, then with him till my Parents arrived, then moved to Elsinore Utah. Married Alice Higgins May 7th 1888. a daughter of C. S. Higgins, and grand daughter of Capt Nelson Higgins, of the Mormon Battalion, worked for myself, mostly hauling freight from Elsinore to Furco. Moved to Dempsey Idaho (now Lava Hot Springs) April 1895, worked on Farm, was Post Master four years, and had a small store, My wife died there, leaving me with six small children, moved to Riverside May 1902, when I am now residing. (Aug 1918) I with my four sons, in a general Merchandise business, have one store at Riverside, and one at Rockford Id.

I have one son and two daughters married, one son served in U. S. Army 22 months, was in France 19 months.

In Church affairs, have been Pres of Deacons, Elders, Y. M. M. S. G. High School <sup>and</sup> in the High Council, and now in the Bishopric.
